# **Quizlet And Vocabulary Mastery: Students' Perception**

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#### ABSTRACT

This study determined students' perception of the use of quizlet application in students' vocabulary mastery. Quizlet is a suitable smartphone-based learning used for learners at various levels of education and at various levels disciplines, not only limited to vocabulary learning. It described the students' perception of the use of quizlet application on the vocabulary of students at Junior High Schools in Bandar Huluan, totaling 20 students. This study used a qualitative descriptive research method in which this research described something as it is by using words, such as observation and interviews to 20 students. The results indicated that quizlet has several benefits in the process of teaching English, especially vocabulary. From the students' perception, it can be concluded that 15 students said that learning vocabulary by using the quizlet application was very comfortable, interesting and easy to understand. On the other hand, 5 students said that learning vocabulary by using the quizlet application was a little difficult to understand. There are several factors why this can happen, including obstacles in operating the quizlet application such as the lack of student knowledge about how to use the features of the quizlet application, and also the lack of internet network access on their smartphones.

Students who do not have a sufficient vocabulary will find it difficult, if not impossible, to communicate. Furthermore, pupils will have difficulty obtaining information and controlling their electronic devices if they lack a basic command of vocabulary and grammar. Given the importance of English, studying English in the classroom must employ the appropriate technique to attract and engage students in order for English competence to be mastered to its full potential (Ulya, 2016).

A flashcard media is a little card with an image on one side and signs, symbols, or explanatory text on the other side that can help pupils learn and understand a content (Arsyad, 2015). The quizlet application was used to create digital flashcards for this study. Quizlet is a learning program created by Andrew Sutherland, a California high school student. Quizlet offers only one feature: flashcards. Quizlet's Flashcard feature is available in digital format and can be accessed via an Android phone or the website (Sari, 2019).

The quizlet application offers various functions in general, including:

- 1. Flashcards are a series of instructional materials created by a teacher in the form of cards or flashcards that can be filled with photos, graphics, or diagrams, as well as their explanations, and can be played consecutively or randomly.
- 2. A study is a group of questions in the form of a flashcard that corresponds to the instructional topic. The learning feature's set of questions is nearly identical to multiple choice questions in which students must select the proper answer. The incorrect question will be asked again and again until the learner replies correctly.
- 3. Writing is a characteristic that is employed as an exercise in the form of an essay.

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- 4. Spell is a feature in audio-visual media that includes texts and visuals, as well as a voice recording as one of the questions that the user can listen to.
- 5. The test is a feature with a lot of difficult questions. Starting with matching, multiple choice, true or false, and essay questions, there's something for everyone.
- 6. Matching is a game feature that allows you to match the flashcard portion of an image to the explanatory text.
- 7. Live is a feature in which players are divided into groups and compete to complete tests in groups (Sari, 2019).

The following are some of the benefits of using the quizlet application as a learning medium on a smartphone.

- 1. Quizlet is a free program that both students and teachers can use. Students will be more motivated to learn since quizlet is a game that they can play, despite the fact that the game in quizlet offers a variety of questions derived from instructional materials displayed in flashcards. Teachers will find it easier to set up teaching materials using flashcards, and they will be able to adapt what learning resources children require (Crandell, 2017).
- 2. Quizlet offers learning media that enables students to become more self-sufficient in their study, whether through laptops, desktop computers, or cellphones (Barr, 2015).
- 3. The quizlet Live feature in the quizlet application can stimulate students to begin learning independently in order to create games in quizlet by integrating learning with entertaining social games. As a result, quizlet Live has arrived as a new breakthrough in learning media that can boost student engagement in class. (Wolff et al., 2016).
- 4. Quizlet connects students who learn in visual, audio-visual, and tactile ways. This is due to the fact that the quizlet app includes not just graphics in flashcards but also buttons for spelling words in Indonesian and other languages. Furthermore, students with kinesthetic learning styles benefit immensely from quizlet, which can be used not just in class but also at any time and place (Quizlet, 2016).

Teachers will find it easier to design and produce teaching materials using quizlet's flashcard function, which can be customized to fit the topic and needs of students. Students who have completed the quizlet features will be automatically added to their learning progress in the teacher's account.

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#### METHODOLOGY

This study used a qualitative descriptive research design. According to Gunawan (2014), qualitative research focuses on the investigation of inductive thinking processes related to the dynamics of the relationship between observable phenomena and always employs scientific reasoning. According to Darmadi (2014: 185), qualitative descriptive research is research that seeks to describe something as it is by using words. This study describes the students' perceptions of the use of the quizlet application on the vocabulary of students in class VII at one of the junior high schools in Bandar Huluan, totaling 20 people. This study used the method of observation and interviews with 20 students.

#### FINDING AND DISCUSSION

Based on the results of observations, obtained 20 perceptions about the use of the quizlet application on students' vocabulary.
